



Ferguson's Viaduct, which traverses the Moy Farm and Sluff, four miles West of Newcastle, Co. Wick, Ireland, carried its last train in 1970. The last steam train (above) travelled from Sluff to Malinbeg on Saturday 3rd June 1972, three years before final closure. The viaduct was re-opened by Iarnród Éireann (IE) in 2009 and is now part of the Wicklow Greenway. This project was supported by IE, Heritage Council, Fáilte Ireland, Wicklow Co.
