Great Southern Trail - N21 Castlematrix, Rathkeale Cycleway / Walkway Scheme (in the townland of Castlematrix)

In accordance with the Planning and Development Acts 2000-2010 and in accordance with Article 81 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001-2010, Limerick County Council hereby gives notice of the following proposal for further development and upgrading works to the Great Southern Trail walking and cycling route at Castlematrix, Rathkeale adjacent to the N21.

The works proposed involve the development of that section of the Great Southern Trail to include the provision of a rolled gravel surface path and all associated drainage, fencing, signage and repair works to structures and also upgrading works adjacent to the N21 at Castlematrix, Rathkeale and to also include the provision of a walkway under the bridge at the river Deel and all associated drainage, fencing and repairs to structures. The section of cycleway and walkway is approximately 600 metres in length.

Plans and particulars, including copies of both the Environmental Impact Assessment and Habitats Directive Assessment Screening, of the proposed scheme will be available for inspection or purchase at a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy, during normal office hours at the Community & Enterprise Section, Limerick County Council, County Hall, Dooradoyle, Co. Limerick and at the Limerick County Council Area Office, Aras Sean Finn, Rathkeale, Co. Limerick from Friday 22nd July, 2011 to Friday 2nd September, 2011.

Submissions or observations with respect to the proposed development dealing with the proper planning and sustainable development of the area may be made in writing to the Community & Enterprise Section, Limerick County Council, County Hall, Dooradoyle, Co. Limerick up to and including Friday 16th September, 2011.
